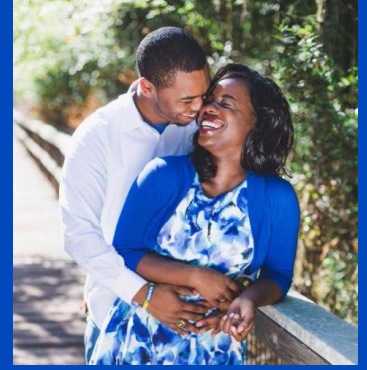


### Our Mission
